

# **IB ADMISSIONS POLICY**

#### **Overview:**

Bedford Road Collegiate has a general application process for all school programs.

Bedford Road also offers motivated students **seeking a challenge and a well-rounded approach** to their high school experience an opportunity to pursue the <u>International Baccalaureate (IB)</u> Diploma Programme of studies. See below for application information. Starting in the spring of 2022, a fee structure will be applied for Diploma and Course students. See <u>letter</u> and <u>FAQ</u> outlining this new policy.

## **GENERAL REGISTRATION**

Bedford Road Collegiate provides online registration for Grade 9-12 students who are new to Saskatoon Public Schools, or students who attended Grade 8 at a Saskatoon Public Schools elementary school and have not previously registered for high school. Students can register by filling out our online registration form <u>HERE</u>.

Once completed, the registration form will be submitted to the school. Administrators and counsellors will then contact the student and family to complete the remaining steps in the process:

- Welcome the student and go through the registration form;
- Support the student in selecting appropriate classes;
- Provide any additional information about registration and our school.

Families that have students who are new to Saskatoon Public Schools and are not Canadian Citizens and/or who do not speak English as their first language, including First Nations, Inuit and Métis students should contact the <u>Newcomer Student Centre</u>.

## **IB DP PROGRAMME APPLICATION**

# OUR ADMISSIONS PROCEDURE WORKS TO MEET EACH STUDENT'S EDUCATIONAL NEEDS AND GOALS.

The IB Diploma Programme is a two year program starting in Grade 11. Grade 10 students planning to apply will have the opportunity to do so after our Collegiate Open House in February.

Components include:

- IB DP Application Form
- Access to student transcripts
- A non-refundable \$550 (Diploma) or \$120/course (Course) fee (due by April 15)

The admissions committee will conduct a review of the application and a student's academic history using student transcripts to ensure pre-requisites satisfy admission. If necessary, an informal interview will take place to ensure the IB Programme is an appropriate educational path. In the event the numbers of successful applications outnumber the number of seats available in any given course, precedence will be given to Diploma applicants.

Applicants will be contacted via letter regarding the success of their application by mid March.
